What plagiarism detection software is available to online instructors?

Turnitin.com

It checks for previous archived student papers, explores through thousands of journals, periodicals & books. It researches active instructors along with a billion web pages crawled. Sweeps over 10,000 educational institutions for information used. Well over 20 million students in 126 countries use it. (http://turnitin.com/static/index.php, accessed Apr.11, 2011)

CheckforPlagerism.net

This sites checks databases, Internet sites, publications, synonym & sentence structure, multiple document comparison and multiple languages. (http://www.checkforplagiarism.net/, accessed Apr.11, 2011)

Viper (Free Download Service)

This site looks like it caters to the student. It helps check editing, scans the Internet to check for plagiarism. You are allow to submit as many times as you'd like. There is no penalty for document length.
